Premier Rondeau

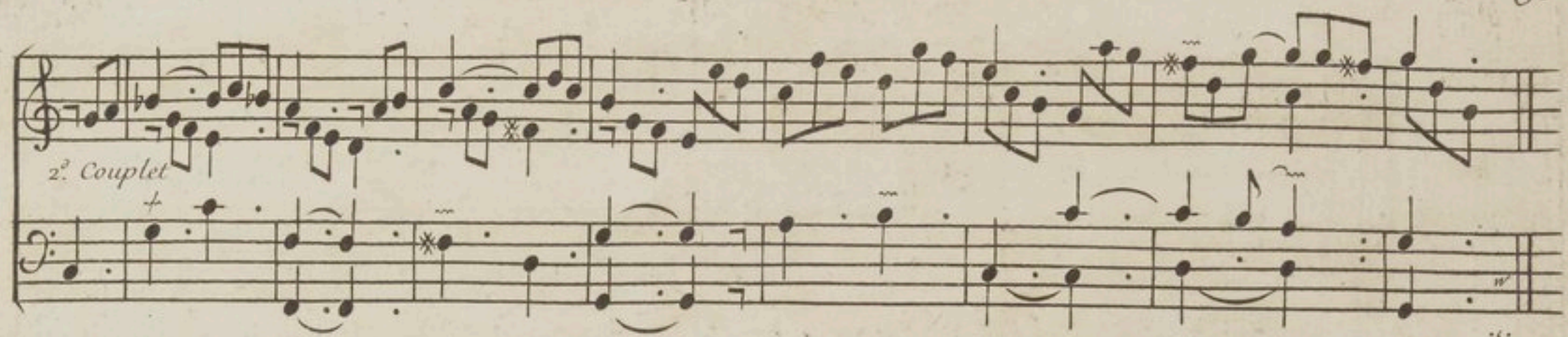
Second Rondeau

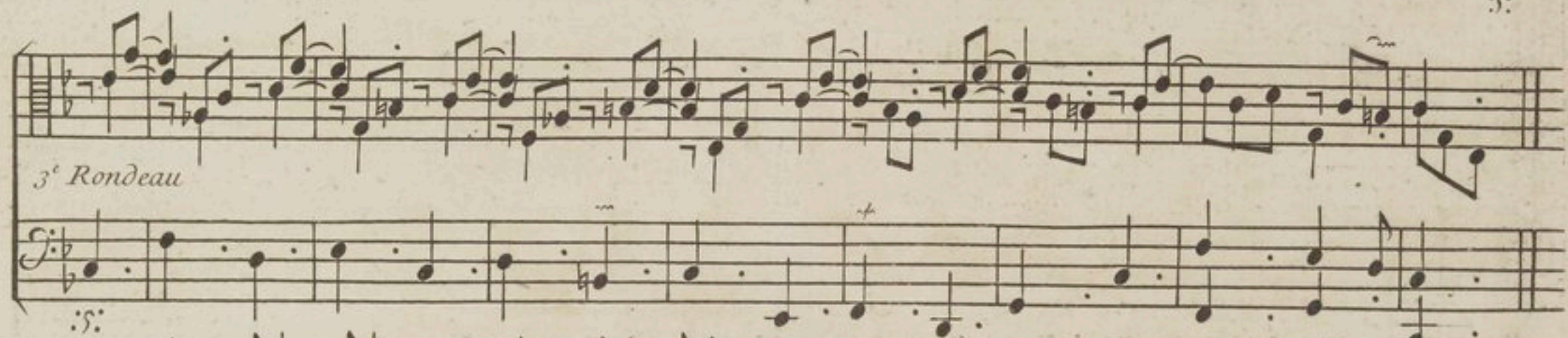
1^r. Couplet
